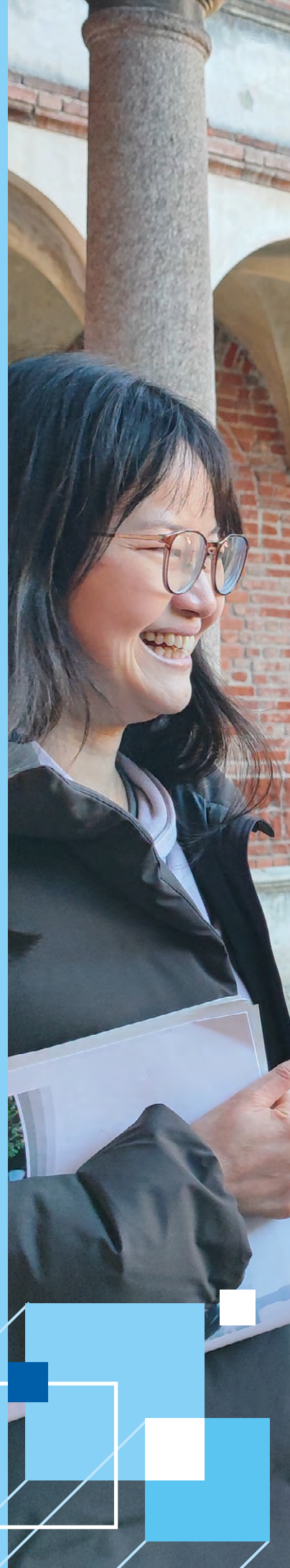
## LOCATION

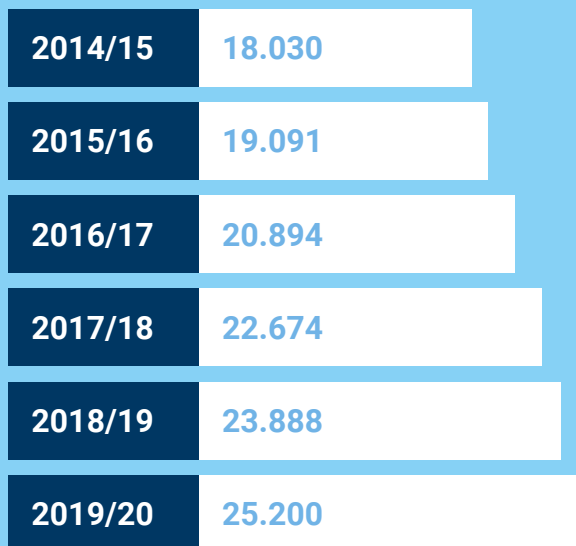
# WHY CHOOSE TO STUDY IN ITALY

Compared to other European countries, tuition fees in Italy are extremely low, especially in public Universities, where tuition fees range from €200 to €5200 per year, depending on family income. Many Universities also offer scholarships to cover the tuition fees and sometimes also housing on campuses and meals in the University cafeteria.

Italy is the cradle of Western civilization: with 60 sites, Italy is the country with the most UNESCO World Heritage sites. It is also home to the oldest University in the world, which was founded in Bologna in 1088!

# WHEN AND HOW CAN I ENROLL IN AN ITALIAN UNIVERSITY



A general requirement that must be met to be eligible to apply to a Laurea (Bachelor's Degree) program is to have 12 years of schooling. Students who do not meet this requirement have to complete a Foundation Year program or acquire extra credits to complement their diploma.

# GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

## 1. IF YOU HAVE LESS THAN 12 YEARS OF EDUCATION

>> Qualifications obtained after 11 or 10 years of global schooling do not allow access to Italian Universities unless you satisfy one of the following additional conditions:

- you attended one (in case of 11 years) or two (in case of 10 years) years of University studies;
- you obtained a post-secondary title to compensate for any missing years of secondary education;
- you attended a preparatory program (foundation year) at an Italian or foreign institution, to compensate for the missing years of schooling.

For students who have attended multiple secondary education institutions, secondary school qualifications will be considered valid if achieved after at least 2 years of attendance in the same education system.

## 2. IF YOU DO NOT HOLD A REGULAR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, OR IF YOUR DIPLOMA IS FROM HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE USA OR THE UK

>> Check carefully as additional documentation may be required (i.e. additional APs or SATs).

**Requirements and procedures to enroll in an Italian University vary depending on whether you are an EU or a non-EU student, and whether you're applying at undergraduate (referred to as 'first cycle') or graduate level (second and third cycle).**

**Each University has a different admission procedure and its own admission test – details about the enrollment procedures can be found on the website of each University.**

# DOCUMENTS NEEDED

It is important to set aside enough time to complete all the registration steps correctly. Start by familiarizing yourself with the University websites and programs well in advance, and ensure that you meet the eligibility criteria for your chosen program. Pre-registrations usually open in February, but it is important to check the specific guidelines on the chosen University website.

**TO APPLY TO AN ITALIAN UNIVERSITY, ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:**

**A**

**FINAL DIPLOMA OF SECONDARY STUDIES** accompanied by a translation in the Italian language officially legalized by the Italian competent Consulate.

**B**

**CERTIFICATE PROVING THE COMPLETION OF 1 OR 2 YEARS OF ACADEMIC STUDIES** or a post-secondary title for those countries where the educational system lasts only 11 or 10 years, accompanied by its legalization or apostille.

**C**

**ITALIAN LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE** for programs held in Italian and **ENGLISH CERTIFICATE** for programs held in English. If you do not have a language certification, you will undergo a language test organized by the University.

The entry **VISA**.

**E**

**PRE-ENROLLMENT:** the pre-enrollment application must be submitted through the Italian diplomatic or consular representation in your country usually from February to the end of July.

**F**

**CERTIFICATE** attesting that the **UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IN THE COUNTRY** of origin has been passed if required by law (e.g. Gao Kao for Chinese students, Suneung for South Korean students, and Vestibular for Brazilian students.)

## THE ENTRY EXAM

The Architectural Entrance Examination (ARCHED) is a crucial assessment designed to evaluate candidates' aptitude and potential for success in architectural studies. Normally, the exam takes place in the second half of July, but dates vary depending on each faculty and University: please refer to the Cisia website ([cisiaonline.it](http://cisiaonline.it)) to know all the different date options.

## THE ENTRY EXAM

Entry to the medical faculties is normally regulated by an online TOLC test. The TOLC exams—TOLC-Med for Medicine, TOLC-F for Pharmacy, and TOLC-Vet for Veterinary studies—are standardized assessments carefully crafted to evaluate the candidates' aptitude for these disciplines. Dates vary depending on each faculty and University: please refer to the Cisia website ([cisiaonline.it](http://cisiaonline.it)) to know all the different date options.

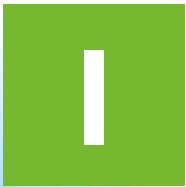

These programs are designed to meet high academic standards and often incorporate modern teaching methodologies, cutting-edge research facilities, and practical clinical experiences. Studying medicine in Italy in English allows you to benefit from the country's rich medical heritage while also accessing a curriculum that's aligned with international standards. Furthermore, Italy's strong emphasis on research and technological advancement ensures that you receive a comprehensive and up-to-date medical education.

With a diverse range of medical schools to choose from, stunning landscapes, a vibrant culture, and a strong reputation in the medical field, Italy offers a truly appealing destination for those seeking to pursue a career in medicine while studying in English. Consequently, interest in studying Medicine programs in English in Italy is on the rise, leading to increased competition each year. Preparing in advance is crucial to enhance your chances of admission. For instance, in 2021, out of 9,209 candidates, merely 1,009 spots were available, and in 2022, from a pool of 12,226 candidates, only 1,049 spots were designated for international students.

The IMAT (International Medicine Admission Test) is a highly selective entry exam that usually takes place in Autumn (as a reference, in 2022 it took place on September 13th and in 2023 it took place on October 17th).

The date is the same for all Italian Universities offering this program, and it is possible to register on the University portal around July.

# THE ENTRY EXAM

Entry to most Design programs in Italy is regulated by selective entry exams, that take place presencially at single Universities. The exam takes place only in Italian and for Italian programs. Exam dates are different for every University, but they normally are in the second half of July. We recommend checking well in advance on the chosen University website.

Some Universities, including Milan Politecnico, will also test the candidates' English knowledge with the TENG exam (Test of English): it consists of 30 multiple choice questions and the minimum score is 24/30. If the candidate has a lower score, they will have to earn extra credits before they finalize the matriculation. Milan Politecnico has its own test called TOLD.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

## ENTRY EXAM

Entry to Italian conservatories is regulated through a combination of entry exams and auditions. The specific requirements and procedures may vary slightly between institutions, therefore it is important to research the specific requirements of the conservatories and programs you are interested in. Here you find a general structure of admission test:

- **Entry exams**

assess the applicant's musical skills, knowledge, and potential: contents include

- Rhythmic theory and ear training (Knowledge of the basic elements of musical language and notation codes),
- Harmony theory and analysis (Sound system, tonal system, horizontal and vertical components),
- History of music (Knowledge of the historical development of music, its periodization through multiple choice questions and music extracts analysis).

- **Portfolio submission**

In addition to entry exams, many conservatories also require applicants to submit a portfolio of their previous musical work.

- **Language Proficiency**

Depending on the institution and program, you will also need to demonstrate proficiency in the Italian language.

As for other specific supplies, students are strongly recommended to bring their own personal equipment.

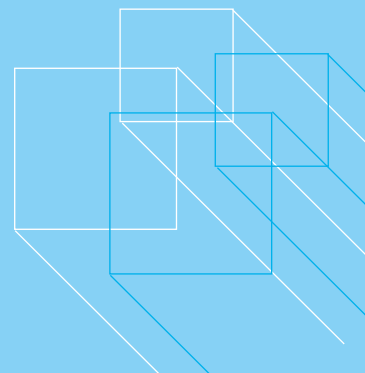
- **CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE**

At the end of all of our courses we issue a certificate of attendance that certifies the hours attended here at school. In order to receive the certificate, students must attend at least x% of the course.

- **VISA**

The procedure for the student visa application is the following:

1. You should fill our online application form on our website **scuolaleonardo.com**
2. Once we receive the application, we will send you an e-mail with all the details about the course and payment methods: we should receive the payment of the global tuition fee in order to issue the certificate of enrollment.
3. To prepare the certificate, we are going to need the following documents:
  - copy of passport
  - information about your previous studies (Italian language level and name of the University/post diploma course you attended)
  - address where you will live in Italy
4. Once we receive the payment for the course and all the documents mentioned above, we will prepare the certificate and send it by e-mail.
5. Besides our certificate, to apply for the visa you will also need the following documents:
  - proof of accommodation
  - bank statement
  - health insurance
  - motivation letter (not mandatory, but highly recommended)
